1. Review of PAR

PAR proposal approved by DASC Steering Committee on 21 June 2001. Peter to make the revisions required to the scope and purpose and submit to IEEE. Peter to establish web site and email list and call for participation.

2. Technical discussion

There was discussion on whether exclusion of Synopsys packages from library IEEE would have any effect. It was pointed out that a simple sed script could revise source code to change library names to a Synopsys library instead of IEEE.

In the interests of equity, the group should do a survey to see if any other vendors add other packages to IEEE.

Peter to submit an IR to VASG to suggest that the next revision of Std 1076 only allow items defined in Std 1076 to reside in library STD.

The group should check the POSIX standard to see how they handle copyright statements in headers and the source-code distribution issue for .h files.
