REPLACE (page 317)

A default actual argument may be specified for a formal argument in the optional associated declaration assignment. The *default_expression* is resolved in the scope containing the sequence declaration.

WITH

A default actual argument may be specified for a formal argument in the optional associated declaration assignment. The *default_expression* is resolved in the scope containing the sequence declaration. Requirements for the type of the default actual argument of a typed formal argument are described in 16.8.1. The default actual argument of an untyped formal argument may be of any type provided its substitution results in a valid sequence as described in the rewriting algorithm (see F.4.1).
